While appreciating your role with regard to your personal attention in implementation of National Food Security Act, 2013 in your district on war-footing basis, it gives me immense pleasure to remind you that the digitization of data and the collection of enrolment forms back, that too in such a huge number is worth praise.

In this connection, now the department is in a position to implement NFSA w.e.f. 01-02-2016. As already discussed during Video Conference held on 05-12-2015, it was impressed upon all the Deputy Commissioners to hoist finalized list on CA&PD and NIC portals in a fixed time frame.

Now after the lists so finalized, it has become imperative to proceed further and in this connection before formal request to Government of India is made by the Department of CA&PD, the following three certificates may be provided to this Department immediately:-

1. That all eligible priority households have been identified, digitized and hoisted on the portal.
2. The priority households have been categorized as AAY, PHH, Non-PHH and Exclusion category.
3. That I am satisfied about the correctness of eligible households identified as priority households, non-priority and exclusion category and certify that no deserving family has been left out.

Furthermore, it may be ensured that ration cards are issued to all categories under NFSA and District & Tehsil level Committees are functioning effectively.

Further, you are also requested that 03 sets of formats at District, Tehsil and FPS level, data be also annexed with your report.

Your initiative / diligence shall go a long way in catapulting your district to acquire bench mark on NFSA and usher the digital era in CA&PD.
