This has reference to the discussions held with His Excellency, The Governor of Jammu and Kashmir State in his office chamber on 29-01-2016 in connection with the progress achieved and to be achieved for implementation of NFSA in the State of Jammu & Kashmir in toto as per the schedule communicated earlier.

Refer Video Conference chaired by worthy Chief Secretary on 28-01-2016 wherein progress for implementation of NFSA was reviewed and one last & final extension was given to your district for completion of fidelity check of already digitized data under various categories of PHH, NPHH and Exclusion.

As you already know that this scheme is time bound and sufficient time had been provided to your district for completion of 03-Stage process. You have also been regularly informed about the timelines, guidelines and latest priorities by way of D.O. letters, telephonic calls and Video Conferences. Since the time is running short, complete the remaining work in your district on Mission Mode at an earliest.

You are requested to personally look into every aspect of implementation of the Act so that the people of the district do not suffer due to delay in implementation of the Act. Since the legacy data sheets which have been utilized for fidelity check are being utilized for data correction. It is advised that a scanned copy of all the digitized forms of your district may be retained for any future cross check, cross validation or de-duplication.

In light of the aforesaid discussions it is enjoined upon you to complete the entire digitization progress as per final agreed schedule during the meeting chaired by worthy Chief Secretary on 28-01-2016.

You are also requested to intimate the progress achieved on this account after the interval of three days regularly.


