Subject :- Providing additional foodgrains, free of cost to AAY households.

Reference:- Council of Ministers Decision No.044/06/2025 dated 27.03.2025.

Government order No:- 25-JK(FCS&CA) of 2025

Dated:- 02-04-2025.

Sanction is hereby accorded for providing additional foodgrains, free of cost to beneficiaries of AAY households, to augment the monthly food requirements of this category of households under Public Distribution System, with the following norms:-

- I. This shall be admissible only in respect of AAY households under Public Distribution System.
- II. Total admissible allocation in respect of beneficiaries of AAY households shall be in such a manner that the entitlement under all the schemes in PDS, including NFSA does not exceed 10 kgs per beneficiary in such households.
- III. The beneficiary wise additional allocation under the scheme shall be as under:-

AAY Household with beneficiary number	Present entitlement (in Kgs)	Additional free food grains to be allowed (in kgs)
1	35	0
2	35	0

4	35	5
5	35	15
6	35	25

- IV. Rice shall be provided in view of its availability under Open Market Sale Scheme (Domestic) scheme presently and same shall be provided free of cost to the eligible beneficiaries.
- V. Finance Department shall be authorized to provide additional budgetary support for implementing this initiative, to be recouped into respective Revolving Fund (Foodgrains) Accounts of both the Directorates.
- VI. Both the Directors shall utilize their Revolving Fund (Foodgrains) Account, for meeting the financial requirements for this purpose after following formalities, prescribed for operation of Revolving Fund.

It is further ordered that as and when, the Department of Food & Public Distribution, Government of India, restarts sale of wheat under OMSS(D), the Department shall explore option of providing wheat and wheat flour, with the approval of the Competent Authority.


