

The allocation is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The validity period for depositing of cost and lifting of allocation for the month of Aril 2015 in respect of APL Category will be upto 30 days from the date of issuance of Allocation letter dated:-05.03.2015 of Govt. of India and for rest of the months it will be as per the instructions/guidelines issued vide Govt. of India's letter No.1-2/2007-BP.III dated:-21.07.2014 already communicated to both the Directors of CAPD Jammu/Kashmir vide this office letter No. CAPD/Plan/03/III/2009-11 dated:-24.07.2014.

2. The validity period for depositing of cost and lifting of allocation in respect of BPL and AAY Categories will be as per the following instructions/guidelines issued by the Govt. of India's letter No.1-2/2007-BP.III dated:-21.07.2014.
 - i. The Directors of CAPD Jammu/Kashmir will ensure the lifting of foodgrains from FCI Depots by the last day of the month preceding the allocation month.
 - ii The cost of foodgrains shall be deposited with the FCI so much in advance that the lifting is completed by end of the previous month.
3. The allocated quantities of foodgrains (Rice/Wheat) are to be lifted in full within the stipulated time ensuring that the ration amongst the Districts is distributed/supplied as per the approved scale under the Targeted Public Distribution System without any re-appropriation/diversification.
4. The monthly lifting/off-take statements as per prescribed format shall be sent to the Administrative Department regularly without fail, besides furnishing of utilization certificates as per prescribed format of Govt. of India.
