Sanction is hereby accorded to the release/reimbursement of Rs.43,53,22,000.00 (Rupees Forty Three Crore Fifty Three Lakh Twenty Two Thousand only) Central share in favour of Director, FCS&CA Jammu/Kashmir through PFMS from Single Nodal Agency Account for Centrally Sponsored Scheme 4048-Assistance to State agencies for Intra-State Movement of foodgrains and FPS Dealers margin under NFSA scheme pertaining to the FY 2021-22 as per Annexure-"A" appended to this Government Order.

Both the Directors shall draw the funds strictly as per the component-wise limit set in Annexure "A" by debiting the official Bank Account of Single Nodal Agency bearing A/C No.0110040510000162 maintained at J&K Bank, Moving Branch Civil Secretariat Jammu for further release/reimbursement, as admissible, to the implementing agencies through PFMS as per fixed component-wise limits.

However, the release/reimbursement of the funds is subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- 1. The funds shall be/have been utilized strictly in accordance with the NFSA, 2013 guidelines and for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned/released.
- 2. The release of funds does not confer the sanction to incur the expenditure, unless and until all codal formalities are observed.

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- The amount shall be kept in SNA Account and drawn through PFMS by the implementing agencies strictly as per laid down component-wise limits for further release/reimbursement of expenditure already made, as per norms.
- 4. The Implementing Agencies shall furnish UC in respect of funds released at an early date in the prescribed Performa.
- 5. The expenditure shall commensurate with the physical progress achieved.
- 6. All codal formalities in consonance with GFR shall be/should have been full filled before incurring the expenditure.
- 7. The expenditure shall be closely monitored and incurred only on such items which are approved under the scheme.
