COVERAGE UNDER PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

IMPROVING EFFICIENCY

The Department of Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs is providing free and subsidized food grains to 25 lac households, comprising 98 lac beneficiaries. 66,56,907 beneficiaries, covered under NFSA, are provided free food grains while 31,55,292 beneficiaries are provided food grains at highly subsidized rate in NPHH group.

Additionally, the Department has also been providing additional top-up, upto 10 Kgs per month, to Priority Households under Prime Minister's Food Supplementation for Priority Households Scheme .

Distribution of 100% fortified rice across all the districts of Jammu and Kashmir has started from October, 2023, under NFSA.

The Department through reforms and technology interventions has aspired to make Public Distribution System credible, transparent and convenient for the beneficiaries.

Effective statutory mechanisms have been put in place to take care of PDS operations for larger public good.

After establishing a State Consumer Commission and ten District Consumer Commissions, **e-daakhil** has been launched to help the consumers to file complaints in an online mode in various Consumer Commissions.
