Approval is hereby accorded to Allocation of Food Grains 2015-16 under National Food Security Act (NFSA) for AAY Priority, Priority and Non-Priority (Tied Over) categories for the month of **February, 2016** in favour of Assistants Directors, Rationing as per the break-up shown in annexure 'A' to this order. The Assistant Director, Trade and Stores, CA&PD, Jammu shall procure Release Orders of the food grains strictly as per the annexure 'A' to this order.

The above allocation is subject to the following conditions:

- i. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of the above revised allocation under NFSA for the month of February and March 2016 will be 30 days from the date of issue of allocation by Govt. of India i.e. 12/02/2016. The validity period for rest of the months will be as per the existing instructions conveyed by the Govt. of India vide letter No.1-2/2007-BP.III, dated 11/07/2014.
- ii. The Cost of the Food Grains shall be deposited with FCI so much in advance that the Lifting is completed by the end of the previous month;
- iii. The Lifting of Food Grains from FCI shall be completed by the last day of the month preceding the allocation month;
- iv. The Lifting of Food Grains from State/District/Tehsil Godowns of CA&PD Department shall also take place simultaneously to the Sale Outlets, so that the Food Grains may be made available to the Rationees from first day of the allocation month;
- v. It should be ensured that the ration shall be distributed/supplied in time among the TSOs as per the approved scale of National Food Security Act (NFSA) without any re-appropriation/diversification;
- vi. Quota to the dealers shall be released equal to the quantity for which they deposit coupons against previously released quantity, it will however not exceed the monthly allocation;
- vii. All other standing orders/instructions issued from time to time by the Administrative Deptt./Directorate wherever applicable must be adhered to strictly; and
- viii. Lifting/Oftake statement and Utilization Certificate as per the prescribed format may be sent to the Directorate by or before 5th of every month.
