

CAPD/Plan/03/iV/2009-11 dated: 17-03-2015 and additional BPL allocation made to the State Govt. by Govt. of India vide letter no. 1-2/2015-BP.III dated: 16.11.2015.



- 2. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of the above revised allocation under NFSA for the month of February and March 2016 will be 30 days from the date of issue of allocation by Govt. of India i.e 12.02.2016. The validity period for the rest of the months will be as per the existing instructions conveyed by the Govt. of India vide letter No.1-2/2007-BP.III dated:-11.07.2014.
- 3. The allocated quantities of foodgrains (Rice/Wheat) are to be lifted in full within the stipulated time ensuring that the ration amongst the Districts is distributed/supplied as per the approved scale under the Targeted Public Distribution system without any re-appropriation/diversification.
- 4. The monthly lifting/off-take statements as per prescribed format under NFSA shall be sent to the Administrative Department regularly without fail, besides furnishing of utilization certificates as per prescribed format of Govt. of India.
